



CARE INSTRUCTIONS COTTON WEBBING

# COMFORT AND DURABILITY

The furniture straps used by ZEITRAUM consist of 90 % recycled cotton webbing and 10 % polyethylene. This material combination provides an optimal balance between sustainability and functionality. The high percentage of recycled recycled cotton and polyethylene content improve stability.

Cotton webbing has a good tensile strength and therefore a good load bearing capacity, which prevents sagging. Seats and backrests made from this material provide secure support and comfort.

# **USAGE AND CHARACTERISTICS**

The cotton webbing of the seats should not be permanently exposed to the sun, as UV rays weaken the fabric and can lead to loss of colour. Light colours fade more quickly, darker colours can fade unevenly.

# **REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT**

The seat made from cotton webbing can be repaired or replaced by a professional if needed. This is particularly recommended if visible wear or damage occurs.

### **CLEANING AND CARE**

Cotton webbing requires regular maintenance to minimise wear and dirt build-up and extend its life. Please consider the following guidelines.

### 1. REGULAR CLEANING

- Dust and dirt can cause wear on the fibres. Vacuum the cotton webbing regularly using a soft
- textile nozzle with medium suction power.
- Avoid using brush attachments to prevent surface damage.

#### 2. STAIN REMOVAL

- Immediate Action: Remove stains as quickly as possible to prevent them from penetrating the fibres.
- Colouring substances: Red wine, fruit juice or syrup may cause discolouration.

In case of contact, act immediately and gently dab the affected area.

- Solid Stains: Gently scrape thicker or solid residues with a blunt knife or spatula.
- Dry Stains: Vacuum the stain to remove loose particles.
- Liquid Stains: Without rubbing the cotton webbing, dab up any spillage with a clean or absorbent cloth.
- Non-greasy Stains: Use a lint-free cloth or sponge wrung out in hot water.

Work from the edges towards the center of the stain.

• Greasy Stains: Use lukewarm water with soap or neutral detergent.

Test the detergent on an inconspicuous area.

### 3. CARE TIPS

- Shampoo the cotton webbing as needed with a neutral detergent, ensuring no residue is left behind.
- Allow the material to dry completely before using it again.
- Do not rub stains vigorously. To protect the fibres, do not stretch damp cotton webbing.
- The material is sensitive to abrasion from colour-intensive fabrics like new jeans.

To protect the cotton webbing, consider placing a cushion on the seat.

• If a stain cannot be fully removed, we recommend professional dry cleaning.
